

**Do you think Labour councillors consult properly before introducing these unwanted traffic schemes in Tuns Lane, Copthorne roundabout, Station Rd?**

We need new councillors who will:

hold Slough's Labour-run council to account for not listening, wasting money and cutting services at the same time.

hold Labour to account for mismanaging the vital Children's services so badly that central Government had to take over.

work harder to improve key areas such as community safety, mental health services and the environment: see back page.

# A Record of Action - A promise of more

## Examples of Robert Plimmer's recent Cippenham action

**Summerlea:** 2014: Robert Plimmer got the Council to clean obscene, racist graffiti from the communal drying area.

**Hunters Way/Nicholas Gdns passageway:** 2014: Robert secured the first promise from the council to clear fly-tipping and litter, but in 2016 had to remind the Council of their promise to regularly check the area for litter.

**Weekes Drive Community Centre car park:** 2015: on behalf of a local resident Robert successfully got some fly-tipping removed.

**Plaines Close/Gervaise Close/Two Mile Brook:** 2015: working with local residents Robert successfully got the gap in the bridge railings repaired and some litter and overgrowth removed.

**Farnham Rd:** 2016: on behalf of a local resident Robert got the Council to clean up the wooden box between Salt Hill Drive/Salt Hill Way.

**Wood Lane:** 2016: A local resident asked Robert to try to get the missing sign for Wood Lane restored at the junction with **Little Chapel Way**. Robert is pressing Eton College who own the road to reinstate it.



## Examples of Robert Plimmer's earlier Council action

From 2004-14 Robert was a hard-working Lib Dem councillor for Foxborough Ward in Langley. He had a strong record of working hard for the local area and the whole of Slough.



**Improving community safety:** 2008/9: as a councillor Robert worked to bring together a range of sources to fund gates in back alleyways. He then got enough residents to sign up to enable the gates to be introduced so as to improve safety.

**Carbon neutral:** in 2009 Robert successfully proposed a motion that Slough Council should go carbon neutral by 2020.

**Fair Trade Town:** as Slough's voluntary Fair Trade Champion Robert successfully led the campaign for Slough to be awarded the status of a Fair Trade Town in 2007 & again in 2009.

As councillor for Foxborough Ward Robert worked extremely hard in 2008/9 to improve community safety. He secured the funding for gates such as this in back alleyways & then spent many winter evenings and weekends signing up enough local residents to enable the gates to be introduced.
