



## ROBERT OPPOSES 3 BIG THREATS TO OUR NHS:

### 1: Underfunding by the Tory Government

Under the Lib Dem plan this money would go to primary care, social care, mental health and a proper increase for nurses and other NHS workers. ### 2: Privatisation by Slough's Labour Council

Lib Dem campaigner Robert Plimmer asks: 'why did Labour run Slough Council privatise school & other medical services?'

NHS nurses and health visitors based at Upton Hospital (see left) learnt in July 2017 that the Labour-run Council has given the contract to run the services they provided for young people to a private company.

This takes the services out of our NHS. *This also reduces integration and could be the start of a slippery slope and the break-up of the NHS. Please help my continuing fight against Labour's NHS privatisation: see back page*

### 3: Privatisation following a Brexit USA Trade deal

Many fear that the Tory Government will be so desperate to do a trade deal with the USA after Brexit that they will agree to President Trump's demands that US private companies be allowed to run some NHS services.


# Slough's housing crisis: Robert Plimmer calls for action

Slough Tories publicly backed daft plans by the Boundary Commission to move Chalvey Ward into Windsor constituency.

This ward includes Salt Hill Park, the Old Town Hall and part of High St. To move it into Windsor constituency would have almost cut Slough in half.

Slough Lib Dems strongly opposed these plans during the consultation. Thankfully the Boundary Commission took notice of what we and others said.
